The ESAL organises meetings with professionals in the artistic field, aimed at informing students and young artists. This is a moment where information concerning all professional and employment queries is discussed ; artists' residences, spaces of research and experimentation, places for diffusing artistic work, together with issues about legal and earning rights, or socio-economical questions related to the status of art assistants or producers.

Many artistic partnerships allow students to fulfill themselves outside the school. During the year museums, art centres, cultural centres, festivals, theatres, and cultural associations welcome projects about the region, representing real professional experiences for students.

## Internships

The main aim is to put into practise the teachings of the school. Internships are compulsory in years 2 and 4 and are recommended throughout the students' course.

## Professional Opportunities

77% of diploma students are occupied in a professional sphere relating to their qualifications. After the diploma, the openings are varied and in constant evolution; liberal artistic practice, positions in the cultural, educational and media-related fields, in scenography, and the creation of events: as gallerist, exhibition curator, illustrator, photographer, production assistant, film/ video maker, editor.

## Options and Diplomas

The Higher Art School of Lorraine - Metz, which comes under the ruling of the Ministry of Culture and Communication delivers the following national diplomas; the DNAP and the DNSEP, the latter being a Masters' degree. Candidates admitted at the entrance examination of 2015 will be the first to sit the DNA grade Licence, within the L.M.D. system.
